STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Providing that Revenues Received in Enforcement of Elevator Law shall be Credited to the General Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 464, amended. The last paragraph of section 464 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Elevator inspectors shall give receipts for all fees and all sums received. They shall pay the same to the supervising inspector who shall deposit said sums with the Treasurer of State, to be credited to the department to be used solely to defray the expenses of such investigations and inspections, and are appropriated for such purposes General Fund. The commissioner may incur such expense as may be necessary to earry out his duties in investigating and inspecting or causing to be inspected such elevators.
