## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 104th LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 394, L.D. 504, Bill, "An Act to Improve the Management of the Indian Township Forest Resources and Passamaquoddy Trust Funds."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 4834." by adding at the end of the first paragraph (same in L.D.) the following underlined sentence:

'From the gross income from the sale of timber and grass the

Forest Commissioner shall make payment to the Treasurer of State

to be allotted the Maine Forestry District for the prevention,

control and extinguishment of forest fires, a sum equal to 6¢

per acre per year for all lands within Indian Township not already

paying a Maine Forestry District tax for these purposes.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 4834."

by inserting in the first line of the 2nd paragraph (same in L.D.)

after the underlined words "net income" the underlined words

'from the sale of timber and grass'
