**AN ACT Permitting Use of Blue Lights on Motor Vehicles Operated
by Constables.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 29, § 1368, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 1368 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

2. Police department vehicles. Lights used on police department vehicles and on motor vehicles operated by chiefs of police, state fire inspectors, inland fisheries and game wardens, sea and shore fisheries wardens, sheriffs ~~and~~, deputy sheriffs **and constables** shall emit a blue beam of light.
