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**RESOLVE, To Reimburse Warren F. Chapman of Skowhegan for Well  
Damage by Highway Maintenance.**

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**Warren F. Chapman; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,860 to be paid to Warren F. Chapman of Skowhegan for salt damage to his well, caused by highway maintenance on Route No. 201 in Skowhegan.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Salt used on Route No. 201 drains onto Mr. Chapman's land and this has entered Mr. Chapman's well and has ruined his water supply. It has become necessary for Mr. Chapman to have a new well drilled, the cost of which is \$1,860. Samples taken by Mr. Merserve of the State Highway Commission and tested at Augusta show salt content at 650 ppm. A water supply becomes unsatisfactory for drinking at 250 ppm.
