IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Repealing Provision for Student Tuition in Coordination of Public Higher Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1865, c. 532, § 4-E, repealed. Section 4-E or chapter 532 of the private and special laws of 1865, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 229 of the private and special laws of 1967, is repealed as follows:

See. 4-E. Student tuition. The current proportionate difference in student tuition between the present University of Maine and the present state colleges shall be maintained through the academic year 1971-1972.
