RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing on Indian, Orange and Sunken Lakes in Washington County.

Ice fishing on Indian, Orange and Sunken Lakes; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Indian Lake, Whiting Township; Orange Lake, Whiting Township and Sunken Lake, Whiting and Marion Townships, in the County of Washington, to ice fishing during February and March of each year.
