HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 415, L. D. 526, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Biennial Elections of Penobscot Indians."

Amend said Bill in the 17th line (14th line of L.D.)  
by striking out the underlined words "for the expired terms"

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the  
Statement of Facts, the following underlined paragraph:

'The tribal governor shall call a general meeting of the  
tribe for the purpose of affirming or rejecting legislative  
proposals prepared by the tribal governor and council for submis-  
sion to the State Legislature. Notice of the time and place of  
the general meeting shall be posted 7 or more days before said  
meeting day at the office of the tribal governor and one  
conspicuous place on Old Town Island. Legislative proposals that  
have received an affirmative vote of a majority of those present  
and voting at the general meeting of the tribe shall be given to  
the tribal representative to the State Legislature for submission  
to the State Legislature.'
