STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Distribution of Axle Loads on Commercial Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1654, amended. Section 1654 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by chapter 364 of the public laws of 1967, is amended by inserting after the 3rd paragraph, a new paragraph, as follows:

When an officer determines that a vehicle, which is within the gross maximum weight licits, is in violation of the axle weight limits, he shall permit the operator to redistribute the load before proceeding and if it conforms to the axle weight limits of this Title, no penalty for such violation shall be imposed.
