SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 162, L.D. 536, Bill, "AN ACT
to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Education Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 14 the following:

'Sec. 14-A. R. S., T. 20, §2356-C, amended. The 2nd sentence
of the 2nd paragraph of section 2356-C of Title 20 of the Revised
Statutes, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 440 of the public laws
of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

The per pupil cost is determined by adding the amounts paid for teachers'
salaries, fuel, janitorial services, textbooks, reference books, school
supplies for desk and laboratory use, public utility services, replace-
ment of instructional equipment, fire insurance and compensation for
the director of vocational education and his assistants, and adjusting
these amounts by the allowable percentages set forth in section 1292
and dividing this sum by the average daily membership of all regularly
enrolled students in the technical and vocational education center.
The rate thus determined shall be reduced by 2/3 and the result shall
become the official tuition rate for the subsequent school year for a
part-time student.'
