AN ACT Relating to Use of Cable Traps to Trap Bear.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2358, sub-§ 3, amended. Subsection 3 of section 2358 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 363 and by section 23 of chapter 404, both of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

The use of the so-called cable trap shall be lawful for use in trapping bear in the State during the open season on bear. The cable trap shall be exempt from section 2451. Cable traps shall have a closing diameter of not less than 2½ inches.
