STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2454, amended. The first sentence of section 2454 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful to hunt deer, bear, and bobcat on Sunday, and possession of firearms and shot, shell or bullets normally used for shooting and killing such game in the fields and forest or on the waters or ice of this State on Sunday shall be prima facie evidence of such hunting unless such firearm is carried, securely wrapped in a complete cover, fastened in a case or carried in at least 2 separate pieces in such a manner that it cannot be fired unless the separate pieces are joined together again.
