SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 437, L.D. 561, Bill, "AN ACT Revising the State Board of Arbitration and Conciliation Law."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting at the end, before the period, the following: 'and Increasing Compensation of Directors of Maine Port Authority'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 3rd line of section 3 (same in L.D. 561) the words "this Act" and inserting in place thereof the words 'sections 1, 2 and 3'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 4. P. & S. L., 1929, c. 114, §2, sub-§(a), amended.

The 3rd sentence of subsection (a) of section 2 of chapter 114 of the private and special laws of 1929 is amended to read as follows:

Each director shall receive from the Port Authority an annual salary of five-hundred-dellars \$800, and shall be reimbursed for all expenses incurred in the discharge of his duties as such director.

Sec. 5. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$2,625 to carry out the purposes of sections 4 and 5. The breakdown shall be as follows:
