IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT To Amend the Charter of Great Northern Paper Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Additional powers granted to Great Northern Paper Company. In addition to all powers, rights and privileges now possessed by Great Northern Paper Company, it is authorized and empowered to sell surplus electricity to any corporation authorized to make, generate, sell, distribute and supply electricity within the State, and it is authorized and empowered to purchase electricity for its mills from any such corporation, and any such transactions are exempt from Public Laws of 1967, chapter 382.
