SENATED AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 440, L.D. 564, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Safety Devices for Railroad Utilities."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§1253-A" of section 1 by striking out all of the first 2 underlined sentences and inserting in place thereof the following: 'The State Highway Commission is authorized to designate any highway-railroad grade crossing on state and state aid highways as a stop intersection and order the railroad upon whose track the grade crossing is located to install and maintain stop signs thereat. The Public Utilities Commission is authorized to so designate such highway-railroad grade crossing on town ways and order the railroad upon whose track the grade crossing is located to install and maintain stop signs thereat. Any expense incurred in installing or maintaining stop signs pursuant to this section shall be borne by the railroad and not by the State or local government.'
