SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 445, L.D. 569, Bill "AN ACT Relating to Damage to Private Water Supplies Resulting from Alteration of Highways.

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§652" by striking out in the 3rd and 4th lines of paragraph B of subsection 2 (2nd and 3rd lines of L.D.) the underlined words "construction of or maintenance on a portion of the state highway system" and inserting in place thereof the words and punctuation 'the commission constructing, re-constructing or maintaining the highway'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of that part designated "§652" the following:

'F. This subsection shall not apply to private water supplies that are created after the effective date of this Act closer than 75 feet to the highway center line, drainage ditches or where the location does not allow for or provide for adequate surface drainage.

G. This subsection shall not apply to private water supplies now located or hereafter located within the right-of-way limits.

H. This subsection shall not apply to any private water supply damaged by construction, reconstruction or maintenance which the commission determines to have already been contaminated or polluted by another source to the degree said contamination or pollution would have rendered it unfit for human consumption.'
