STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Maintenance of a Public Building in Rumford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1915, c. 116, § 2, amended. The last paragraph of section 2 of chapter 116 of the private and special laws of 1915, as enacted by chapter 35 of the private and special laws of 1941, is amended to read as follows:

Beginning with the year 1941 1969, the County of Oxford shall pay to the Town of Rumford, the sum of 51,000 annually towards the maintenance of the court rooms, the jury room, the lock-up and other facilities provided in said building for the accommodation of the officials of said county.
