AN ACT Relating to Death Benefits before Retirement Under State
Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1124, sub-§ 4, additional. Section 1124 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 4 to read as follows:

4. General salary adjustments. At any time that a general salary adjustment is made to state salaries, the same percentage increase or decrease shall be applied to the payments made under this provision. At any time that any beneficiary becomes ineligible that portionate amount of adjustment applicable to that recipient shall cease. All adjustments shall become effective on the first day of the month following the effective date of the active state employees' salary adjustments.

Participating local districts may provide such adjustments in the survivor benefits provisions by application to the board of trustees and shall supply a certified copy of its action with a statement of agreement of payment of costs.
