IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Amending the Law Relating to Requests for Autopsies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 3028, amended. The first sentence of section 3028 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 534 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

If, in the opinion of the medical examiner, the Chief Medical Examiner the county attorney or the Attorney General, it is advisable and in the public interest that an autopsy be made, such autopsy shall be made by the Chief Medical Examiner, or by such pathologist as may be designated by the Chief Medical Examiner for the purpose.
