

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 104th LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $_{\rm A}$  " to H. P. 452, L. D. 589, Bill, "AN ACT to Remove the Prohibition Against Running Horse Racing During Certain Weeks in the Months of June and July."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT Relating to Horse Racing During Certain Weeks in the Months of June and July.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause (same in L.D.) the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 8, §271, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 271 of Title 8 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Notwithstanding-anything-in-this-chapter-to-the-contrary; the-commission-shall-issue-a-license;-where-pari-mutuel-betting-ispermitted;-to-Gorham-Raceways-to-hold-day-or-night-harness-races or-meets---in-Corham-each-year-for-a-period-of-4-weeks;-and-no-more; beginning-in-June-on-the-Monday-of-the-last-full-week-therein-which has-7-calendar-days;-except-said-commission-may-issue-each-spring-alicense-to-Gorham-Raceways-for-an-additional-period;-ending-on-the date-said-4-week-period-begins;---If-ne-running-racing-is-held-at-Scarborough-Downs-after-babor-Bay-each-year;-Gorham-Raceways-may-bepermitted-to-hold-harness-races-or-meets-at-Gorham;-but-only-if-said-

harness-waces-or-meets-at-Gowham-held-after-Labor-Bay-shall-not-be detrimental-to-the-best-interests-of-the-agricultural-associations of-Mainey-or-any-of-them. The determination as to whether or not such harness races or meets are detrimental shall be made by the commission after a public hearing following due notice to all parties concerned. The number of quinella races, or any similar types or designations, in any day of racing, shall be determined by the commission.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line, after the enacting clause, (same in L.D.) the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'
