RESOLVE, Discharging Town of Shapleigh from Part of the Indebtedness to State Board of Education for Preparation of Agreement for Dissolution of School Administrative District No. 57.

Town of Shapleigh; discharge of certain indebtedness. Resolved: That all of the indebtedness exceeding \$1,000 of the Town of Shapleigh, as the municipality petitioning for dissolution of School Administrative District No. 57 for reimbursement for the expenses paid by the State Board of Education for employment of competent advisers in preparing the agreement of dissolution of said district, as provided in the Revised Statutes of 1964, Title 20, section 222, is discharged.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Town of Shapleigh, as a participating member of S.A.D. #57, petitioned the State Board of Education for dissolution of the district. An agreement for dissolution was prepared and the State Board of Education now claims reimbursement in the amount of \$2,484.91. The purpose of this resolve is to discharge the Town of Shapleigh from payment over \$1,000.
