STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Transfer of Funds from Maine Sardine Council to Department of Agriculture for Sardine Inspection Activities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 36, § 4699, sub-§ 2, ¶ D, additional. Subsection 2 of section 4699 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph D, to read as follows:
 - D. For transferring funds to the Department of Agriculture for helping to finance the inspection of sardines as defined under Title 32, section 4155, when in the opinion of the council such action is necessary for the accomplishment of such inspection. The council has the sole authority to determine when such a need and emergency exists and to fix the amount of sardine tax funds that may be transferred.
