RESOLVE, Providing Funds for Dental Education.

Dental education; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated to the Department of Education from the General Fund the sum of \$12,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 and \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970, to be expended for the purpose of extending opportunity in dental education for Maine residents in accordance with the New England Higher Education Compact.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The New England states have signed a compact to provide greater educational opportunities and services through the establishment of a coordinated program for persons residing in the several states for furthering higher education in the fields of medicine, dentistry, veterinary medicine, public health and in professional, technical, scientific, literary, and other fields. An opportunity now exists for 4 Maine students to enter accredited dental colleges in other states. The resolve would extend the same benefits to 5 dental students.
