RESOLVE, Relating to Ice Fishing in Spednic Lake, Washington County.

Ice fishing in Spednic Lake regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Spednic Lake T9-R4N, T10-R3N, and Vanceboro Townships, Washington County to ice fishing for salmon from February 1st to March 31st of each year.
