HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 471, L. D. 625, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Mental Illness as a Ground for Divorce."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 8th and 9th line
(8th, 9th and 10th lines of L. D. 625) the underlined words
"mental illness requiring confinement in a mental institution for
at least 7 consecutive years next prior to the initiation of a
divorce complaint" and inserting in place thereof the following
'confinement in a mental institution by reason of mental illness
continued for not less than 7 consecutive years next prior to the
filing of the divorce complaint,'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last
underlined sentence.
