AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials and Jury Commissioners of Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 14, § 1252, amended. The first paragraph of section 1252 of Title 14 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 3 of chapter 414 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

The jury commissioners for the several counties shall each receive for their services the following sums per year, and expenses: Androscoggin, \$175; Aroostook, \$125; Cumberland, \$275; Franklin, \$100; Hancock, \$100; Kennebec, \$125; Knox, \$100; Lincoln, ~~\$100~~ \$200; Oxford, \$100; Penobscot, \$125; Piscataquis, \$75; Sagadahoc, \$100; Somerset, \$100; Waldo, \$100; Washington, \$100; York, 100.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to Lincoln County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Lincoln County: County commissioners, ~~\$7,100~~ \$1,300; chairman, ~~\$1,300~~ \$1,500; clerk of courts, ~~\$5,000~~ \$5,500; county attorney, \$5,000; county treasurer, \$1,500; sheriff, ~~\$5,000~~ \$5,500; register of deeds, ~~\$5,000~~ \$5,500; judge of probate, ~~\$4,500~~ \$5,200; register of probate, ~~\$4,700~~ \$5,200.
