SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 497, L. D. 651, Bill,
"AN ACT Permitting Employment of State Prison and Reformatory
Inmates on County and Municipal Public Works Projects."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end (same in L.D.) the
following underlined sentence: 'If prisoners in the State
Prison or inmates of the Men's Correctional Center are used
for such employment, they shall be paid wages that are comparable
to the wages paid regular employees who are doing similar work.'
