HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 223, L.D. 663, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Expunging of Certain Records of Arrest."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following Title: 'AN ACT Requiring the Filing of Records of Acquittal or Dismissal of Crimes.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 5th and 6th lines (4th and 5th lines in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'RECORDS OF ACQUITTAL OR DISMISSAL

§600. Records of acquittal or dismissal'

Further amend said Bill in the first paragraph of that part designated "§600." (same in L.D.) by striking out all of the next to last underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentences:

'Upon the receipt of the certified copy, each agency shall make the information therein contained a part of its records and shall not thereafter release a transcript of its records or portion of its records relating to the person without the entry of acquittal or dismissal being included therein. Thereafter, upon demand of

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the person, any such agency shall permit the inspection of its records by the person or shall be required to furnish a transcript of such records free of charge to the person, in either case, excluding investigative and communication records, fingerprints and photographs, in order that the person may determine that the agency has complied with these provisions.
