COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 505, L.D. 676, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Electricians Examining Board
and Membership and Compensation of Oil Burner Men's Licensing
Board."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting
in place thereof the following Title"

'AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Electricians Examining Board
and Membership of Oil Burner Men's Licensing Board.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 32, §2351, amended. The first sentence
of section 2351 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended
by section 8 of chapter 249 of the public laws of 1967, is further
amended to read as follows:

An Oil Burner Men's Licensing Board, as heretofore established and
in this chapter called the "board," shall consist of ~~a chairman who~~
~~shall be the Director of State Fire Prevention, ex-officio~~ an
executive secretary who shall be the Insurance Commissioner or a
representative of the Division of Fire Prevention delegated by the
Insurance Commissioner subject to the approval of the majority of
the board, and 4 other members, called the appointive members, who
shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of
the Council.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 32, §2351, amended. The last sentence of section 2351 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 8 of chapter 249 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

The members of the board, except those who are state employees, shall each be allowed the sum of \$20 per day and all members shall receive their necessary expenses for travel, board and room while attending to the necessary duties of their office.

Sec. 4. R. S., T. 32, §2351, amended. Section 2351 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 8 of chapter 249 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentences:

The 4 appointive members of the board shall annually in the month of January choose one of their members as chairman. The executive secretary shall be a voting member of the board.

Sec. 5. R. S., T. 32, §2352, amended. Section 2352 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

Such employees shall be located in the Insurance Department and under the administrative direction of the Insurance Commissioner.'
