STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Providing for the Outlawing of Trading Stamp Disbursement by Certain Business Establishments Selling Motor Fuel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 10, § 1258, additional. Title 10 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1258, to read as follows:

§ 1258. Stamps by business selling motor vehicle fuel

It is declared illegal for any service station or any business engaged in selling motor vehicle fuel to disburse trading stamps as defined, unless they have purchased a license from the Secretary of State's office and have paid a registration fee of \$5,000 annually for each and every service station in the State of Maine engaged in disbursing trading stamps.

If any such station disburses trading stamps without paying said registration fee, they shall be punished by a fine of \$1,000 for each and every disbursement.
