IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Tuition Charges for Special Education Classes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 3116, amended. Section 3116 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following paragraph:

Any unit operating a section or school under the authority granted in this chapter may compute a tuition rate as follows: The unit may charge the basic per pupil allowance as set out in section 3722 times the adjustment factor for special education students as set out in the same section, or the unit may charge its actual per pupil operating cost of the preceding year increased by 7%, whichever is lesser. Per pupil costs are defined as all of those expenditures except transportation, capital outlay and debt service.
