COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 508, L. D. 679, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Administrative Units to Operate Classes for Trainable Children."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by inserting before the word "Trainable" the words 'Educable or'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, §3111, amended. The last sentence of section 3111 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

~~Special-classes-in-public-schools-are-to-include-educable-children only.'~~

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'
