STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Failure to Undergo Tuberculosis X-Ray Tests.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 1048-A, additional. Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1048-A, to read as follows:

§ 1048-A. Failure to take tests

Any person, who is suspected of being afflicted with tuberculosis by any physician or by any local health officer and who refuses to undergo tests for tuberculosis, whether by X-ray or otherwise, shall be punished by a fine of \$500.
