AN ACT Relating to Closed Season on Wild Hares in Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2356, amended. Section 2356 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful to hunt wild hares or rabbits in the County of Waldo with dogs during the open season on deer.
