STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Damages for Tortious Conduct of Charitable Corporations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 14, § 158, amended. The last sentence of section 158 of Title 14 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 28 of chapter 513 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed as follows:

The amount of damages in any such case shall not exceed the limits of coverage specified in the policy, and the courts shall abate any verdict in any such action to the extent that it exceeds such policy limit.
