AN ACT to Amend the Law Relating to the State's Right of Appeal.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 15, § 2115-A, sub-§ 1-A, additional. Section 2115-A of Title 15 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 547 of the public laws of 1967, is amended by adding after subsection 1, a new subsection 1-A, as follows:

1-A. Hearing after notification by State. The State, by motion prior to trial, may request a hearing to determine if physical objects obtained by search and seizure, a statement made by the defendant or conversation obtained by means of electronic surveillance, will be admissible at trial.
