STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Liquors Manufactured or Bottled in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 28, § 55, sub-§ 3, amended. The last sentence of subsection 3 of section 55 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

The commission shall in their purchases of liquors give priority, wherever feasible, to those made from the agricultural, **manufactured or bottled** products of this State.
