COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 528, L.D. 699, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Neglect of Official Duty by Municipal Officers."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A municipal officer, either elective or appointive, acting in a quasi-judicial capacity as a member of an administrative body, shall be responsible for his decision in a civil action where bad faith or malice, or both, are shown. Such responsibility shall not exceed the sum of \$5,000 for any one member. Nothing contained within this paragraph shall be considered as constituting an additional penalty within the meaning of this section.'
