STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Neglect of Official Duty by Municipal Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2254, amended. Section 2254 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

Municipal officers holding elective or appointive positions and not acting in a quasi-judicial manner or occupying the position of a judge shall be responsible for decisions made individually, or jointly as a body, in any civil action where bad faith or malice, or both, or other evil motives are shown. Such responsibility shall not exceed the sum of \$5,000 for any one member.
