STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Union River Anadromous Fish Restoration Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund, in favor of the Atlantic Sea-Run Salmon Commission, the sum of \$35,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 and the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972, to carry out a program of anadromous fish restoration in the waters of Union River Bay and estuary. All unexpended balances shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing account, until June 30, 1975.

Sec. 2. —1975 and 1976. There is appropriated from the General Fund, in favor of the Atlantic Sea-Run Salmon Commission, the sum of \$6,000 per year for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1975 and June 30, 1976, to carry out a program of continuing evaluation of the anadromous fish restoration in the waters of the Union River Bay and estuary.
