**RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of Two Hundred Copies of History
of Parkman.**

History of Parkman; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 for the State to purchase 200 copies of the book entitled "History of Parkman" by Roger Storms, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It has been the practice of the Legislature to encourage the publication of books dealing with the history of towns in Maine and thus preserving the history of the State.
