

## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 104th LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 590, L. D. 732, Bill, "An act Providing Funds for the Official Observance of the 150th Anniversary of the Formation of the State of Maine."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the list of counties and inserting in place thereof the following:

'There is also appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Maine State Sesquicentennial Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969, the sum of \$18,000 to be expended for the expenses of the commission and an additional \$28,000 for printing the "Maine Guide" and any revenue produced by the sale of the "Maine Guide" shall be credited to the General Fund. Any balance of the \$18,000 remaining at June 30, 1969 shall not lapse but shall remain a carrying account until June 30, 1970. The breakdown shall be as follows:
