SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 557, L.D. 738, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Governmental Immunity in Civil Actions."

Amend said Bill by striking out the period at the end and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'during the period a policy of insurance is effective covering the
liability of such governmental agency. Each policy of insurance
issued to such governmental agency shall contain a provision to the
effect that the insurer shall be estopped from asserting, as a defense
to any claim covered by said policy, that such governmental agency
is immune from liability on the ground that it is a governmental
agency. The amount of damages in any such case shall not exceed the
limits of coverage specified in the policy, and the courts shall abate
any verdict in any such action to the extent that it exceeds such
policy limit.'
