STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Governmental Immunity in Civil Actions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 14, § 157, repealed and replaced. Section 157 of Title 14 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 8-A of chapter 425 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 157. Government agencies

In all civil actions against the State of Maine or any political subdivision thereof or any quasi-municipal corporation or quasi-governmental agency, whether acting in its governmental or proprietary capacity, the defense of governmental immunity is abolished.
