## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Certain Disqualifications Under the Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 26, § 1193, sub-§ 3, ¶ B, sub-¶ (4), additional. Paragraph B of subsection 3 of section 1193 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subparagraph (4) to read as follows:
  - (4) If the commission determines that refusal has occurred for cause of a necessitous and compelling nature, the individual shall be ineligible for the week in which the refusal occurred and while such inability or unavailability continues.
