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### **AN ACT** Relating to Licensing of Premises for Dancing Purposes.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 8, § 162, amended.** Section 162 of Title 8 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and deplaced by chapter 265 of the public laws of 1967, is amended by adding at the end the following sentence:

**Any person by himself, his clerk, servant or agent who is proximately responsible for a dance held in violation of this section, is equally guilty with those persons enumerated in the first sentence of this section.**
