# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to Credit for Military Service Under State Retirement Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1094, sub-§ 13, amended. The 2nd sentence of subsection 13 of section 1094 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 497 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

A state employee shall be entitled to this credit only if at point of retirement he shall have at least 15 years of membership creditable service in the State Retirement System.
