HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 578, L. D. 763, Resolve, Proposing the Acceptance of a Master Plan Prepared by the Capitol Planning Commission.

Amend said Resolve by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'The Capitol Planning Commission, the State Highway
Commission, the Bureau of Public Improvements and the
State Planning Office are authorized and directed to continue
work on the Master Plan of the Capitol Complex. A revised
and extended plan is to be submitted by the Capitol Planning
Commission to the 105th Legislature, which plan is to include
evidence of a coordinated Highway-Capitol Complex Plan and
evidence of plans and uses for other state land in Augusta
and surrounding communities.'
