STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Authorizing Harness Racing Commission to Employ a Veterinarian.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 8, § 280, amended. Section 280 of Title 8 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

The Harness Racing Commission is authorized to employ a State Veterinarian. The duties of the veterinarian shall include the medical and physical examination and testing of horses to assure compliance with the statutes, and advising the commission of any violation thereof.
