## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fees for Transcripts of Evidence Furnished by Official Court Reporters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 4, § 651, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 651 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

They shall furnish a transcript of so much of the evidence and other proceedings taken by them as either party to the trial requires, on payment therefor by such party at the rate of 26e for every 100 words \$1 per page of 250 words.
