STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Property Abutting Throughways in Certain Cities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2151, amended. Section 2151 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by inserting before the next to the last paragraph, the following paragraph:

In municipalities of 10,000 or more inhabitants, all of the abutting properties along throughways which have been so designated pursuant to Title 29, section 948, may be used for commercial and industrial purposes notwithstanding any municipal ordinance.
